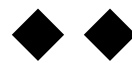

Dues were due beginning May 1st for the 2003-2004 term. A late fee of \$40 now applies to all renewals only. Please refer any questions or comments to your officers or board members.

Basic dues are \$50 and Lodge dues are \$75. In addition, there are multiple prepaid discount plans this year which can be applied to family and guests as well. Also, we have expanded family membership rates too. First adult in family is \$75 and each additional adult is \$50 (children over 18 in college with valid ID would still remain in the family membership). Membership for all children under 18 is free.
